Each year, the Epilepsy Foundation of Greater Chicago educates over 10,000 people in the Chicago metro area about epilepsy, seizures, and first aid. Our FREE audience-appropriate programs are designed to create the most positive impact on children and adults. These programs include:

SCHOOL

- **Seizure Training for School Personnel**
One hour, ISBE accredited training that covers seizure recognition, first aid, treatment options, and action planning.
- **Managing Students with Seizures for School Nurses**
2.5 hour training (CEU available) that covers seizure recognition, first aid, treatment options, how to educate other staff and manage students with seizures in a school setting.
- **Seizure Smart Students**
30-45 minute age appropriate training that covers seizure recognition, first aid, and treatment options.
